

Catch-up Premium Plan 2020-21

There are currently 248 pupils on roll (Reception to Y6) as of 11.9.20. The government have committed £80 per pupil catch-up funding, equivalent to £19, 840 based on the current number of pupils. Funding will be determined by the 4 to 15 pupil head count in the October 2020 census. Funding is paid in 3 tranches – an initial part payment in Autumn 2020, a second payment and a third payment in the summer 2021.
