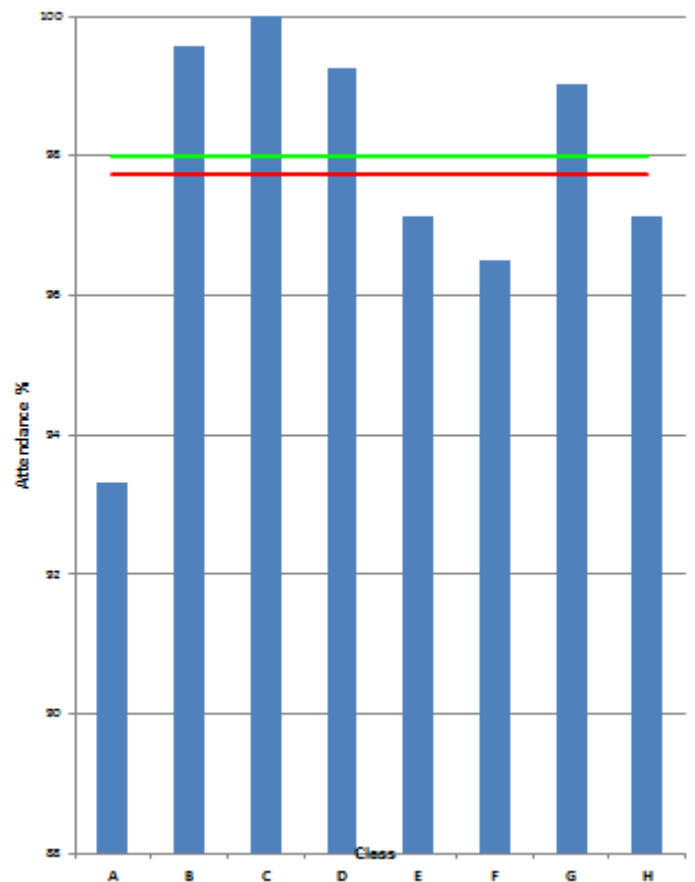

SCHOOL UNIFORM NEWS!

From now on uniform (apart from ties ,water bottles and hoodies) will not be available for sale at school. We now have an online St Peters' Shop using the same supplier as we have in the past and have negotiated down the cost of some school uniform items. When purchased online you can also have your child's name printed free of charge on the label. There are three methods to retrieve your item: Pick up at school or from the shop in Warrington (free of charge), or delivery to your home address (charge).

Please note that the option of using Tesco has been removed as they have been taken over by another company and the prices went up rather than down. For further information, please read then letter that has been given to each child last term.

Wearing a school uniform is very important, apart from looking very smart and St Peters' is a particularly smart uniform, it is also part of our identity; children should be proud to wear it. We have ensured that the school badge is on all items (apart from the PE shorts and the round neck PE shirt) .
