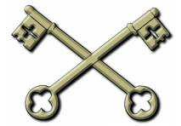

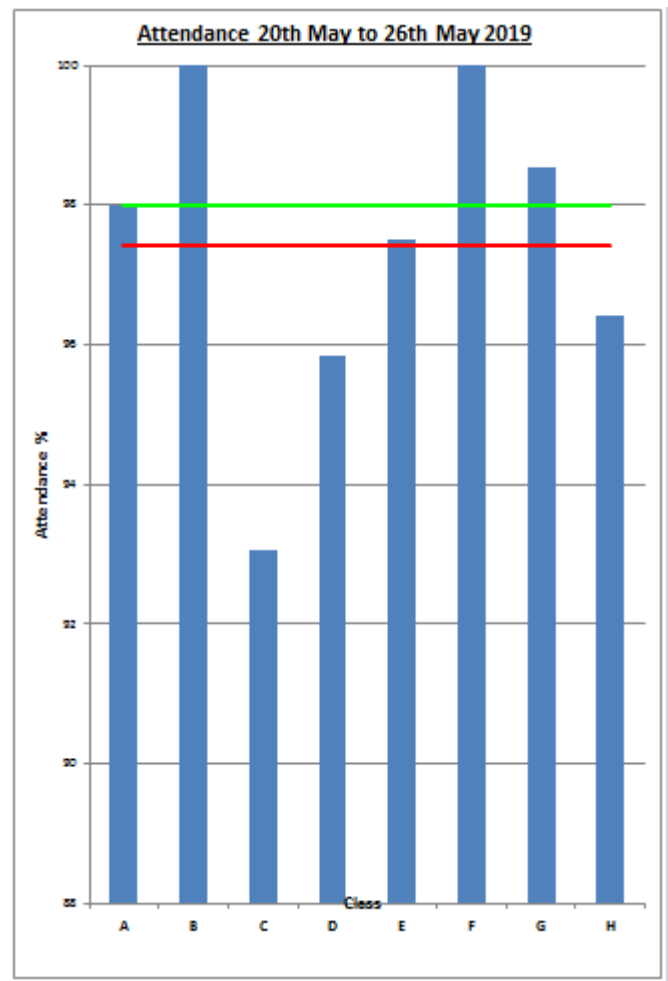

Payment details

Children are taught in groups of about three for half an hour during the school day. There will be 30 sessions across the school year at a cost of £6.60 per lesson for which payment can be made monthly by 10 standing order payments of £19.80 or by 3 termly payments of £66 in advance of each term.

All equipment will be provided they just need help from families.

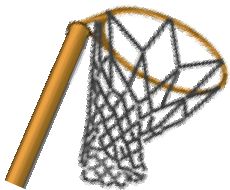
Put the date in your diary and go along to help transform the Remembrance Meadow.
