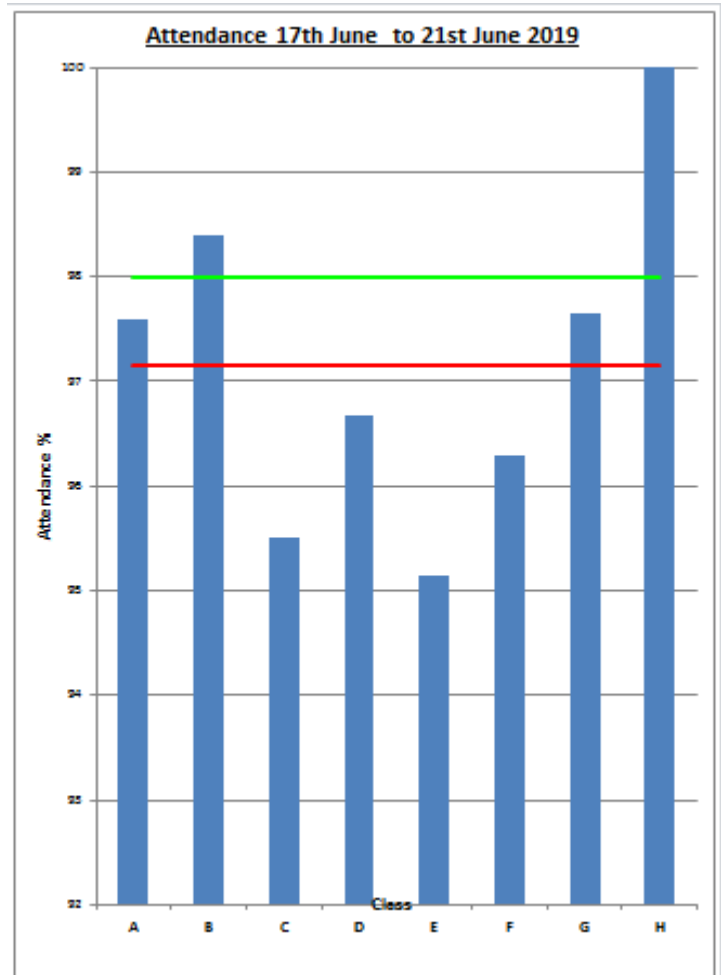

MUSICAL INSTRUMENT TUITION

The Schools Music Service Roadshow will be visiting school with a selection of musical instruments to explain how your child can receive instrumental tuition at school on:-

Tuition is offered in school to pupils on violin, keyboard, ukulele and guitar. Pupils must have their own instruments and we can help and advise you about purchasing or hiring them at the meeting.

Payment details

Children are taught in groups of about three for half an hour during the school day. There will be 30 sessions across the school year at a cost of £6.60 per lesson for which payment can be made monthly by 10 standing order payments of £19.80 or by 3 termly payments of £66 in advance of each term.

The lessons are for Year 1, Year 2 and Junior children.
