School Uniform Reminder

A polite reminder about our school uniform policy:

•No jewellery can be worn apart from a normal watch. (If you want your child's ear pierced, this should happen at the start of the school summer holiday) we will allow clear plastic earring retainers to help pupils on return to school if required.

- Appropriate school shoes should be worn, not boots or black trainers.
- •No hoodies in place of a school jumper/cardigan unless on a PE day.

<u>Absence</u>

If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea please note that they should not return to school for a period of 48 hours after the last incident. This is a local authority policy

In accordance with Government and Local Authority policy, holidays taken during term time will only be authorised in <u>exceptional</u> circumstances.
