Concept	What does it mean and why do we learn it?
Collage	Collage describes both the technique and the resulting work of
	art in which pieces of paper, photographs, fabric and other items are arranged and stuck down onto a supporting surface.
Printing	Printing is the process of making images that can be transferred
	onto other surfaces. It can be used to make one or more identical
	images or to create repeating patterns on papers and textiles.
Sculpture	Three-dimensional art made by one of four basic processes:
	carving, modelling, casting, constructing.
Painting	Painting is the practice of applying paint or other media to a
	surface, usually with a brush. In art, the term painting describes
	both the act of painting, (using either a brush or other implement,
	such as palette knife, sponge, or airbrush to apply the paint); and
	the result of the action – the painting as an object.
Sketching	Traditionally a rough drawing or painting in which an artist notes
	down his preliminary ideas for a work that will eventually be
	realized with greater precision and detail. The term also applies to
	brief creative pieces that per se may have artistic merit.
Drawing	A picture or diagram made with pencil rather than paint.
