Dear Parent / Carer,

This week we held our Inspiration and Aspiration week. A huge thank you to all the parents who came into our Key Stage 2 classes to talk about their jobs and inform and inspire our children. The feedback I've had from all the classes has been amazing and they are very appreciative of the time and effort you have set aside for them.

A key rationale for starting career education early is drawn from evidence which shows that young people form their aspirations and ideas about careers long before they are old enough to become employed. Very young children typically articulate a strong gender bias in their thinking about jobs. One of the many objectives this week is to break this gender bias and to broaden all our pupils' aspirations about the different types of careers that are out there. We will do this again next year.

Last week, the parents' forum met and we talked mostly about our school uniform. Our uniform is staying the same, we all like it, however the school is looking to relax a few areas to ensure that during these difficult times, our uniform remains affordable. The forum came up with some interesting ideas for us to investigate and we will publish our new uniform policy for September 2022 in the next few weeks. Please note that if you have bought items already, this is fine as the actual uniform itself hasn't changed.

The preparations for the Summer Fair are well underway, however this can only be a success if we all get involved. This will be the first one since before Covid and somehow, I've been nominated to go in the stocks! The PTA are working hard to make this a memorable event. In the next few weeks, they will be asking for your help with non-uniform days, please support them and also save the date – Saturday July 2nd 12pm – 3pm.



Absence

When reporting on the absence line, can we politely request that you leave a brief description of your child's illness rather than just saying they are unwell. If your child has vomiting or diarrhoea please note that they should not return to school for a period of 48 hours after the last incident. This is a local authority policy

Applications for Holiday Leave must be submitted to school at **least 4 weeks** in advance. Forms can be found on the school website or requested from the school office. In accordance with Government and Local Authority policy, holidays taken during term time will only be authorised in **exceptional circumstances**.
